- Take short showers and turn off shower whilst soaping down.
- Turn off taps whilst brushing teeth.
- Support our bed linen and towel environmental policy.

Conserve Energy

- Switch off lights when you leave your room.
- Close your window when you have your radiator on.
- Only boil the amount of water you need when making hot drinks.

Say NO to single-use plastic and glass; refill your water bottle at the water station.

Leave rubbish such as batteries, glass bottles, cans and newspapers on the tray in your room or next to the bin, for us to remove and recycle when servicing your room.
